

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
6. Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
7. Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
8. Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
9. You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
10. You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.

AVAILANCHE HAZARD AREA
Indicates an area is permanently closed for safety reasons including cliff or cornice danger.

SKI AREA BOUNDARY
The area beyond this boundary is hazardous backcountry terrain. Persons proceeding beyond this point should be prepared for avalanche danger, weather changes, terrain hazards and be equipped and trained for self-rescue.

FRESH TRACKS MOUNTAIN TOP BREAKFAST
You're already heading up the mountain, so why not start with breakfast at the top? Board the Whistler Village Gondola between 7:30am-8:30am for a mountain-sized breakfast buffet at the Roundhouse Lodge, then enjoy early access to the runs. Purchase advance or day-of tickets at Guest Relations or any ticket window. Tickets are open-dated for the season and breakfast is limited to the first 650 people daily.
